This distinguished group show includes the work of Brandon Bauer, Shan Bryan-Hanson, Jessica Campbell, Debbie Kupinsky, Brian Pirman and Katie Ries. Composed as it is of multiple voices, there is no one thematic organizing principle, rather, there are many: presence, daily lived experience, community, storytelling, the environment, the body, social injustice, power, and multiple interpretations of beauty. The work on exhibit is as varied in media and approach as it is in concept – ranging from sculpture and multi-media installation, to printmaking, drawing, various methods of collage, and fiber constructions.
